My concern is the long term care issues that many of the members of our congregation are dealing with: chronic pain, chronic disease, battling cancer, and/or the loss of a spouse or a child. The initial outpouring of love and support is wonderful, but as time goes on, our lives move on but their lives are still caught up in dealing with the pain and the struggles of an ongoing or chronic illness.

Let me encourage you to look over our prayer list and pay particular attention to those names that have been on there a number of weeks. Review the names of those who live at Colony Court or the Memory Care Center or Lake Shore Inn. Look around and take note of who hasn't been in church for a while. Write those names down and send them a card, give them a call, pray for them or visit with them. These actions will encourage the person who is struggling with their illness and their families who support them. It will remind them that they are loved and not forgotten, but above all they will know they are not alone in their journey.
