*PASSING THE PEACE

LIGHTING OF THE FOURTH ADVENT CANDLE: Fulfillment or Peace

LEADER: "In those days a decree went out from Emperor Augustus that all the world should be registered. All went to their own towns to be registered. Joseph also went from the town of Nazareth in Galilee to Judea, to the city of David called Bethlehem, because he was descended from the house and family of David" (*Luke 2:1,3-4*). Today we remember Joseph, worn-out traveler and worried husband, doing what was necessary for the sake of his family, the burden of poverty stifling his hope in the promise of God. There was no room for him, yet he knows to whom he belongs.

ALL: Today we give thanks for the Josephs among us, migrating far from home when there is no choice, fiercely devoted to the ones they love, unwavering in their belief that there is room for all in the kingdom of God.

LEADER: On this fourth Sunday of Advent, we light this candle as a symbol of Joseph, who knocks at the door, ready to take his place among royalty. (Light two purple candles, the rose candle, and the last purple candle.)

OPENING PRAYER (in unison)

LEADER: He taught the way of love for God and neighbor, For stranger and enemy, for outcast and alien.

ALL: We have confidence in Jesus.

LEADER: Who called disciples, led them, gave them new names and new purpose And sent them out to preach good news.

ALL: He washed their feet as a servant. He walked with them, ate with them, called them friends, rebuked them, encouraged them.

LEADER: Promised to leave and then return, and promised to be with them always.

ALL: He taught them to pray. He rose early to pray, stole away to desolate places.

LEADER: Fasted and faced agonizing temptations, wept in a garden, and prayed, "Not my will but your will be done."

ALL: He rejoiced, He sang, He feasted, He wept.

LEADER: We have confidence in Jesus,

ALL: So we follow him, learn his ways, Seek to obey his teaching and live by his example.

LEADER: We walk with him, walk in him, abide in him, As a branch in a vine. We have not seen him, but we love him.

ALL: His words are to us words of life eternal, and to know him is to know the true and living God.

LEADER: We do not see him now, but we have confidence in Jesus. Amen.

LEADER: Now the birth of Jesus Christ took place in this way.

- ALL: When his mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child from the Holy Spirit.
- LEADER: And her husband Joseph, being a just man and unwilling to put her to shame, resolved to divorce her quietly.
- ALL: But as he considered these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary as your wife, for that which is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit.
- LEADER: She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins."
- ALL: All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had spoken by the prophet: "Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall call his name Immanuel" (which means, God with us).

LEADER: When Joseph woke from sleep, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded him: he took his wife,

ALL: but knew her not until she had given birth to a son.

LEADER: And he called his name Jesus.

ALL: In those days a decree went out from Caesar Augustus that all the world should be registered.

LEADER: This was the first registration when Quirinius was governor of Syria. And all went to be registered, each to his own town.

ALL: And Joseph also went up from Galilee, from the town of Nazareth, to Judea, to the city of David, which is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and lineage of David, to be registered with Mary, his betrothed, who was with child.

LEADER: And while they were there, the time came for her to give birth.

And she gave birth to her firstborn son and wrapped him in swaddling cloths and laid him in a manger, because there was no place for them in the inn.

LEADER: This is the Word of God for the People of God.
