
CONGREGATIONAL RESPONSE

"'But you, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; for out of you will come a ruler who will be the shepherd of my people Israel.'"

NARRATOR: Ben had lived in the same house all of his life. He was a poor man with just enough sheep and land to "keep the wolf away". He was a simple man. He seldom traveled into the nearby village of Bethlehem. In fact, he seldom went anywhere.

You see Ben is an old man. He doesn't like the word old. He had rather be called a "village Elder."

BEN: I grabbed my small shepherds crook and ran to where all the noise was coming from. There was a great light that filled the sky. My brothers and even my father fell to the ground and cried out in fear. We thought God was bringing about the great day of judgment the prophets had predicted. Suddenly, God's angel stood among us and God's glory blazed around us. We were terrified.

WOMEN: The angel said, "Don't be afraid. I'm here to announce a great and joyful event that is meant for everybody, worldwide: A Savior has just been born in David's town, a Savior who is Messiah and Master. This is what you're to look for: a baby wrapped in a blanket and lying in a manger."

BEN: At once the angel was joined by a huge angelic choir singing God's praises:

ALL: "Glory to God in the heavenly heights Peace to all men and women on earth who please him."

BEN: As the angel choir withdrew into heaven, we talked it over and said, "Let's get over to Bethlehem as fast as we can and see for ourselves what God has made public to us."
