# **Good News from the Conference Office**

We received a letter from the Minnesota Conference office on June 22. Here is an excerpt from that letter:

"Over the years, Faith UMC had accumulated an unpaid apportionment balance of \$115,022.96." As you may be aware, it is the annual conference's policy to automatically release 25% of this accumulated unpaid apportionment balance for each year apportionments are paid in full. Because of your full payments in 2019, 2020, 2021, and 2022, we have released another 25% or \$28,755.74 of the total accumulated balance. This leaves a remaining balance of accumulated unpaid apportionments of \$0.00."

A special thank you to each of you who have consistently supported Faith Church in a manner that made this possible! Please note, however, that our members' receipts have been steadily declining over the past several years. It is unknown at this time whether Faith Church will be able to pay all of its apportionments in 2023.

The Bible doesn't specifically reference butterflies anywhere in Scripture, but as part of God's natural creation, they provide a beautiful picture of spiritual transformation. The metamorphosis from caterpillar to butterfly has striking parallels to Christian conversion, resurrection, and transfiguration. And that is exactly what being a Christian and living a life for and through Christ is all about! Letting go of what we were so we can become something much better!

When a butterfly starts its journey, it is a small helpless caterpillar. It has only two jobs to do, to eat and to grow. Does that sound similar to a new Christian? When we are first saved, it is crucial that we begin to feed on God's Word. This is how we grow and mature in order to be used by God.

The Bible says that anyone who belongs to Christ has become <u>a new creation</u>. The old life is gone, and the new life has begun (<u>2 Corinthians 5:17</u>). The same God, who takes a caterpillar and changes it into a butterfly, transforms sinners into saints.

When a butterfly emerges its wings are limp and unusable. It is not until the butterfly has done some work that it can actually use its wings and fly. We as Christians are like this as well. We are saved by God's grace but the transformation does not stop there.
