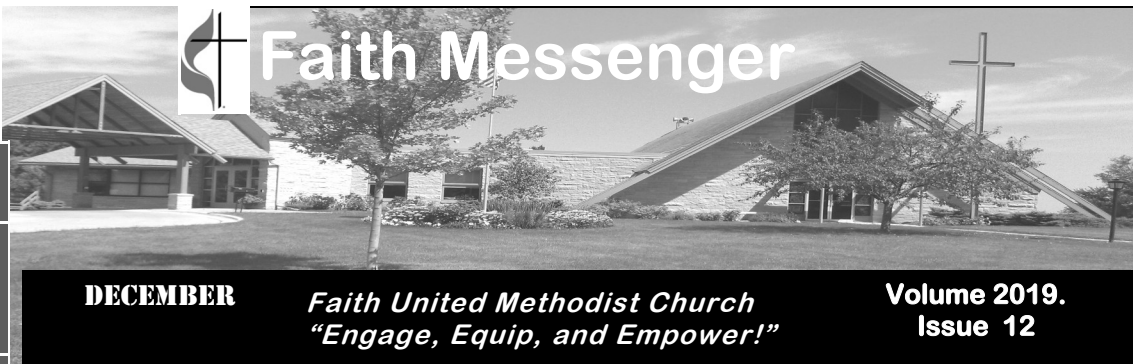

**A Healthy Fear of God**

*Proverbs 3:7 Be not wise in your own eyes; fear the LORD, and turn away from evil.*

We see God as a God of love and He is. We talk a lot about the grace of God and how we do not have to add anything to what Jesus has done for us on the Cross. Grace is indeed free and our salvation complete.

So why are we told to "fear God"? Is that just for the Old Testament or does that command have a claim on our lives today?

In Proverbs 15:33, the fear of the Lord is described as the "discipline" or "instruction" of wisdom. Writing in the Catholic Encyclopedia, Jacques Forget explains that this gift "*fills us with a sovereign respect for God, and makes us dread, above all things, to offend Him.*"

A healthy fear of God is a deep respect for God's power and majesty. It is a healthy understanding that God is in control of life and we are not. It is a deep desire not to offend Him through our words or actions and it is a motivation for both avoiding and turning away from Evil and opposing it in whatever for we encounter it.

A healthy fear of God places the God of scripture at the center of our lives. He is the only one we worship and adore. He is the only one we bow down to and obey. He is the one we trust above all others.

When we lose sight of who God is we lose our healthy fear of God and we replace the God of scripture with "other gods" or idols.

Idolatry is the worship of, being, or a physical image, such as a statue, or a person in place of God, the worship of something or someone other than God as if it were God.

**Five Ways to Recognize an Idol in Your Life**  
(the "it" can be a person, place or thing)

1. Are you willing to compromise your beliefs to get it or keep it?
2. Do you get angry If you can't do It/don't get It/or someone gets close to it?
3. Do you value It over people/are you willing to hurt or manipulate others to get it or keep it?
4. Does It push you closer to God or pull you farther away?
5. How does it impact on your walk with God?

### Faith In the Future

YOU can help assure the long term financial stability of Faith Church! A few years ago, a small group of dedicated members from Faith Church created the Faith in the Future Fund with the Waseca Area Foundation. This fund would provide annual grants to Faith Church to be used as determined by Faith Church. It is an endowment fund to last into perpetuity with only the interest used each year.

The spending rate from the fund is based on a five-year rolling average of the fund's current market value not to be less than 4.25% or more than 5.5%. Investment returns in excess of the spending rate are added to the balance of the assets in the fund.

In 2019, the grant to Faith Church was \$1,381. The fund balance on Sept. 30 was \$35,997. There are many ways to give to the Faith in the Future Fund:

All gifts are exempt from state and Federal income taxes.

In the unlikely event that Faith Church no longer exists, the Agreement with the Waseca Area Foundation states that the annual grants shall go to the successor church in Waseca. A successor church would be the result of merger, consolidation, reorganization or the like.

Everyone has a Will. Either it is one that you have created that spells out exactly what you want done with your assets in the final distribution, or it is one that the State provides. This latter one is not very personalized! Have you created your Will or updated your existing one lately? This is a good time to do that.

Include a provision that at least some your assets are given to the Faith in the Future Fund. In this way you will know that your gift will last forever. For more information, contact Neil Fruechte at 507-384-1454.

Let us each follow the example of Paul when he writes: *Philippians 3:12 Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already arrived at my goal, but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me. 13 Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, 14 I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.*

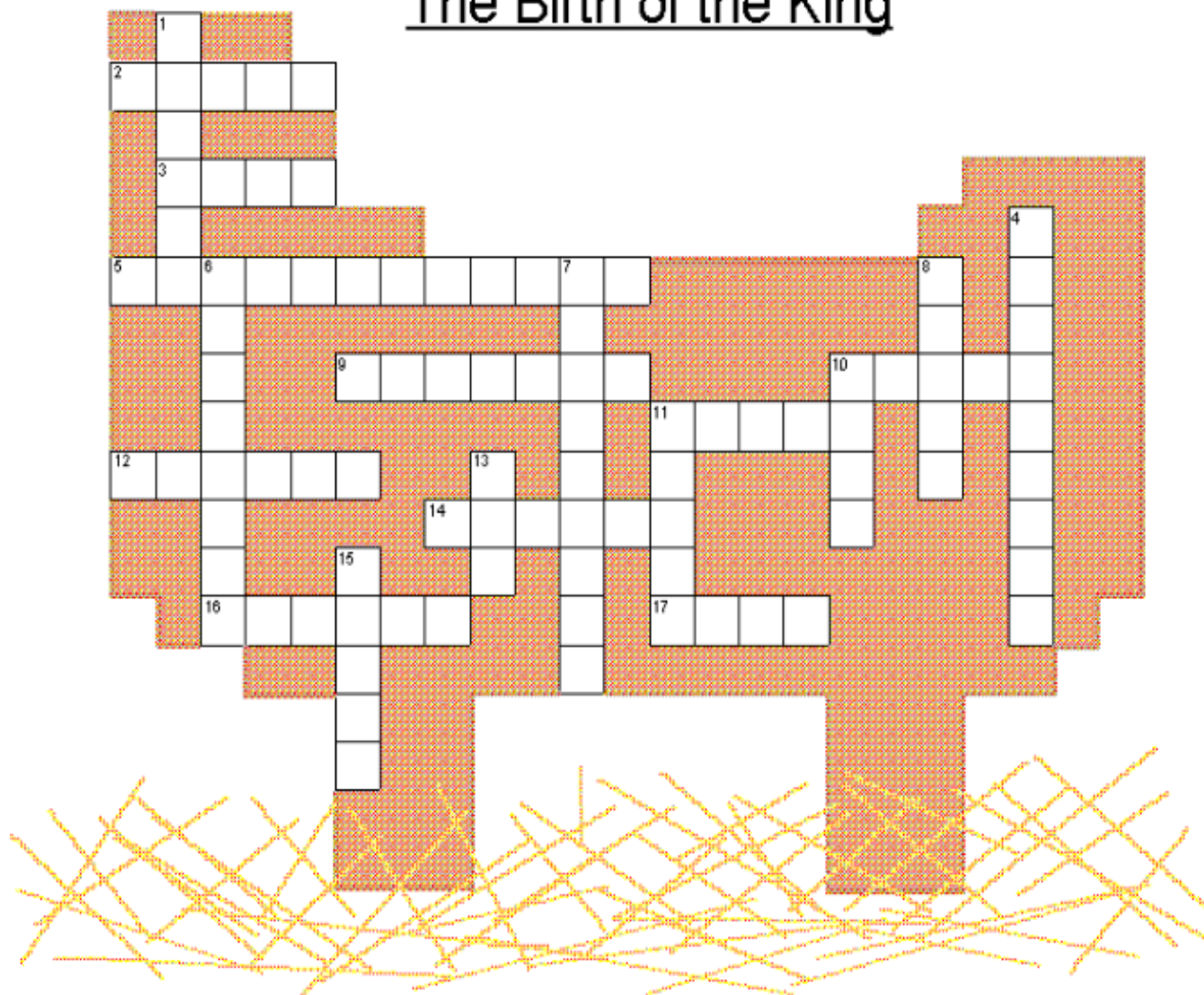
