Back when I was a little squirt, I caught some kind of bug and soon found myself with mom in the office of Dr. Huffington, whose office was located in Waterville, next to the Rainbow Hotel. I was still a little tyke so mom had to help me hop up on the exam table as we waited for the Doctor to come. I was so scared because I didn't know what the Doctor was going to do. The last little bit that I can remember about this episode in my life is that on the way home in the car, I tried to apologize to mom for crying in the doctor's office, she gently replied by saying "that's OK, you were just scared". It is amazing how powerful fear can be.

Report from the Finance Chair

2023 is drawing to a close. By the time you read this, it might have already happened. Thanks again for all who responded to the SPECIAL ASK. Because of that we were able to pay all our operating expenses for 2023 including 100% of our apportionments. Our greatly reduced pastoral and janitorial expenses during the last six months were also major contributing factors.

This is a reminder to turn in your 2024 pledge. This is tremendously helpful as we prepare our 2024 financial budget. We ask that you turn them in by January 10. Be sure to include your plans for the Trustee's budget. Those budget needs are significant especially when considering the upcoming need to replace the west half of the roof, upper floor windows, parking lot repairs, and the assessment expected for the repairs to Eighth Street. None of this will happen all at once but we will need to face these costs over the next few years.
